RCCC has grown from a single vision of a few individuals to a multi-faceted organization that serves hundreds of individuals annually. Initially focused on peer support and offering a place of belonging, we've expanded to provide a wide range of recovery services, including recovery coaching, housing first recovery coaching, family navigators, life skills workshops, youth café, and more.

### Our history

Founded in 2017, RCCC began as a vision of a small group from the Southwest Washington Addiction Recovery Coalition (SWWARC). After touring the Recovery Café Network's flagship location in Seattle, this group spent time planning, consulting, and preparing to bring a similar model to Clark County. In October 2017, RCCC became an Emerging Member of the Recovery Café Network, and in 2018, we opened our doors. Since then, we have proudly served as a safe, supportive community for individuals recovering from addiction, mental health challenges, and homelessness.

## **RCCC Programs & Services**

### **Recovery Cafe + School for Recovery**

- The Recovery Cafe is now home to 300 members.
- Over 50 meals are served daily by volunteers and members.
- The School for Recovery trains and certifies members to become Recovery Coach Certified, and to continue their education with courses such as Ethics, Professionalism, and peer support techniques.

### **Access to Recovery**

- RCCC is the new home for Clark County Access to Recovery (ATR).
- Over 1,000 individuals have been connected with RCCC ATR to gain recovery support services.

### **Recovery Navigator Program (RNP)**

- Provides 24/7 one-on-one substance use disorder (SUD) support to individuals referred by law enforcement, medical professionals, and child welfare staff.
- Offers immediate response, peer support, and personalized recovery plans to address each individual's unique needs.
- Aims to intervene swiftly and connect participants to vital recovery resources for long-term success.

### **VHA Housing First Recovery Coaching**

- RCCC Recovery Coaches serves participants at Vancouver Housing Authority Permanent Supportive Housing sites.
- Provides funds for basic needs including food, transportation, housing support, health, and employment.

### **Family Navigators**

- Collaborate with schools and organizations like NEXT, SeaMar, Transitional Youth Services, and various legal and probation services in Clark, Klickitat, and Skamania Counties.
- Assists families with recovery services and court reunification of parents with their children.

## **Pop-Up Cafe**

- Hosts recovery cafes in Stevenson, Washougal, Goldendale, and White Salmon.
- Activities, recovery coaching, support circles, food, and connection for members in rural areas.

## **Recovery Coaches**

- Coaches meet people where they are in their recovery journey, offering one-on-one support and acting as a motivator, cheerleader, ally, and advocate.
- Coaches help set and achieve goals, connect to resources, and celebrate victories, focusing on promoting recovery and removing barriers.

## **Recovery Coaching Trainings**

- Provides comprehensive training and certification for individuals to become Recovery Coaches, empowering them to support others on their recovery journeys.
- Offers courses on Ethics, Professionalism, and peer support techniques, equipping trainees with the skills needed to help individuals set and achieve recovery goals.

## Impact
